To the club members and committee members with interests in the Suburbs-Piako Hockey Club. Please accept this chairman's report for the financial year 2019-2020. To be tabled at the next Annual General Meeting.

In 2019 the club ended the year with 5 teams, which consisted of 4 men's teams and 1 women's team. With the following records.

Premier Men	Placed 7th in Intercity
Premier Development Men	Placed 2nd in Prem Dev Competition
Reserve Men	Placed 2nd in Reserve 1
Pastits Men	Placed 1st in 3rd division, promoted to Reserve 1.
Reserve Women	Placed 4th in Women's Reserve 2

With some adjustment and player movements noted during the year, the Premier men's performance in 2019 went one better than 2018. Placing 7th in the Intercity competition out of a possible 14.

The Premier Development Men registered a number of good wins throughout 2019. Further showing that this team tends to cater to a good mix of youth and older players. They secured 2nd position, in a tough contest with Old Boys.

Growth at Reserve men's level has occurred. With the security of masters players, as well as mid-age players who give back to the game. This has signaled that the 2020 season will have further growth and interest in our Senior men's teams Pastits and Reserve Men's teams, with a possible expansion to a 2nd Reserve men's team.

Women's Hockey returned for 2019. Whilst recording various wins and losses, women's hockey is seen to be rebuilding in Suburbs-Piako. 2020 has seen new players and numbers return.

The club has retained its player base from 2019, with many returning for 2020. With the majority of new players coming into the Premier Men's side, which is now coached by Toby Platt.

Special mention to our committee, who have met each month, including in the offseason, to plan, secure coaches, and management. Also to seek ideas and concepts for new equipment, resources,

and sponsorship to name a few. It is fair to say that Suburbs-Piako Hockey Club is in the best position it has ever been in.

The Club has been blessed to have also secured some sponsorship. From 'The Cosmetic Company', owned and managed by Warwick Kiely and Allyson Gofton. This sponsorship will go a long way in helping with new uniforms, equipment, and disbursements. A huge thank you to them.

The 2020-2021 season has not started the way we are used to with the COVID-19 pandemic causing major issues to competitions here and around the world. The challenges ahead are keeping our player base strong, having player well-being as our primary focus, and getting our club members back onto the field for enjoyment from a year that began by being flipped upside down.
